Important Things to Remember:

^{*}Please continue to send payments by mail until the, "Bank Draft. Do Not Pay" notice appears on your bill. You must also have a zero balance before the draft can be set up.

^{*}Remember that the amount deducted each month for your water/sewer service will vary. Although the amount of your bill probably doesn't change much from month to month, there is always the possibility of an unexpected increased charge due to a leak or additional usage.

^{*}Payments on accounts that have been terminated by the customer will not draft from the customer's account. Your Final Bill will need to be paid with another payment option (check, card or cash).
